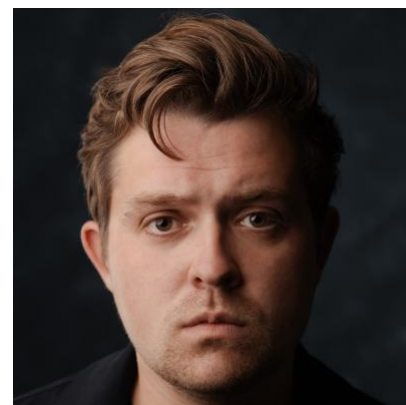


## Jack Loxton
