

John Stewart Collis

John Stewart Collis was born in 1900 of an Irish family. He was educated at Rugby School and Balliol College, Oxford. Among his publications are SHAW (1925), THE SOUNDING CATARACT (1936), DOWN TO EARTH (1947) – which won the Heinemann Foundation Award, THE LIFE OF TOLSTOY (1969), THE VISION OF GLORY (1973), CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS (1976) and LIVING WITH A STRANGER: A DISCOURSE ON THE HUMAN BODY (1976). He also contributed to THE GENIUS OF BERNARD SHAW (1976: ed Holroyd). John Stewart Collis died in 1984.
