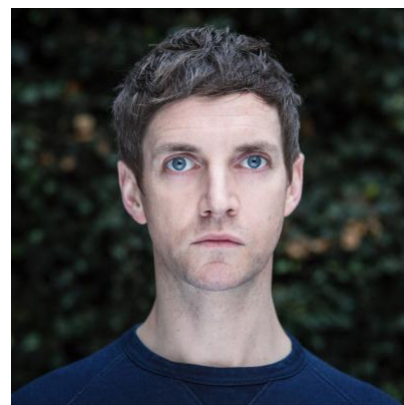


## Emmet Kirwan
